Washington Beer Awards First Ever Fresh Hop Competition results announced

Seattle, WA, October 10, 2019: Specialty Competitions LLC is proud to release the results of the first ever Washington Beer Awards[®] Fresh Hop Competition. The competition was held with the endorsement of the Washington Beer Commission as a way to celebrate Washington's growing brewing culture and recognize excellence in the craft. All of Washington's craft breweries were invited to submit entries to the competition held in a similar format to other craft beer competitions like the Great American Beer Festival® and World Beer Cup®. This focused competition focuses on beers brewed with fresh, unprocessed hops aiming to showcase the unique characters of the "fresh hop beer" style category.

Single Hill Brewing from Yakima cleaned house by medaling with each of their four entries! Seattle's Reuben's Brews also made a very strong showing with three medals including two golds. Dru Bru and Burke-Gilman Brewing Company won the highly contested Fresh Hop IPA and Fresh Hop Juicy or Hazy IPA categories, respectively.
